Submission Guidelines

- Articles should be submitted to the following addresses--preferably in electronic format. Articles stored as electronic word-processor documents (e.g., MS-Word or WordPerfect for Macintosh or Windows) and figures saved as JPEG graphics formats should be sent as e-mail attachments.
- Hard-copy article manuscripts may also be submitted.
- Suggested manuscript length is a maximum of six pages (approximately 2,500 words) in Times New Roman font (size 12).
- Upon submission please include your full name, address, phone number and e-mail address(s). You may also add a short description of yourself including your activities. Please do not exceed 100 words.
- Please keep a copy of your work; manuscripts will not be returned.
- Articles submitted for consideration will undergo editors' review and the editors reserve the right to edit the articles for clarity and to avoid issues that may provoke disunity.
- Selection of articles is within the sole discretion of the editors and the Magazine Committee.
- Deadline for the submission of articles is December 31, 2007
- The articles may be written in English, Burmese or any Chin dialect.
